Atelier Momo Inc. created the electronic medical record (EMR) software, Doctor's Good Will, 23 years ago and has continued to enhance its functions based on the "WYSIWYG" (What You See Is What You Get) concept and the advanced, "Problem Oriented Medical Record" (POMR) method.

HYPER LINK OF MEDICAL RECORD NO.2

The Medical Record No. 2 form is a structure for ordering collections of medical information in Japan. Previously, "lumbar spine X-P", "abdominal echo" and "electrocardiogram" were merely "character strings" in the paper chart, but now they can be linked with images and waveform information in a patient's electronic medical record. With hypertext conversion, all medical information from in or out of hospital visits can be consolidated on the Medical Record No. 2 form. Notably, thumbnails of documents created with Pages, Numbers, Keynote, iMovie, Voice Memo, etc. can be displayed on the Medical Record No. 2 form. Doctor's Good Will can directly call the "iPad Pro" memo application as a medical record creation tool. It can also retouch the selected part of a photograph taken with an iPhone, add a brief note, and process a detailed schema drawn with Apple Pencil onto the Medical Record No. 2 form. Many doctors have been waiting for this, along with complete PDF conversion.

ESSENCE OF WRITING MEDICAL RECORD: "HANKO"

By digitally incorporating a lot of the Hanko¹ on a doctor's desk into the input interface, it's possible to quickly enter a patient's primary complaint, initial observations of an examination, test results, the patient's medical history, medications prescribed, and the name of the illness and its treatment plan. In addition to the Medical Treatment Fee Schedule Table², it'll be possible to speed up the processing required for requesting a receipt when writing the medical record! With the link between digital Hanko and other Hanko, and the link between Hanko and Receipt, "software that enables 100% source input at medical examination" was achieved. Hanko has many options and one is linked to another, for example, if you choose "Fever" Hanko, it links to "Flu" Hanko.

PROCESS FLOW OF INTERNAL WORK

Doctor's Good Will is compatible with the OS operating system for the first time in Japan. It can only be used with Macs, which cooperate with most medical instruments used in hospitals. DICOM image calling, smooth cooperation with modality equipment such as CR (computed radiography), as well as hearing equipment is included. It also enables seamless integration with Apple devices.

HISTORY OF DGW

"Why did you become a doctor?" "Why are you going to start a business?" "What kind of examinations will you do?" Ask multiple doctors these questions, and the answers will vary greatly.

One of the frequently recurring answers is about being "considerate" to the patient. Based on "sympathy" for patients, many doctors want to provide high-quality medical services. This also helps clarify the response to "What kind of electronic medical record are you looking for?"

Aiming to create a "considerate" clinic, Doctor's Good Will was born in 1996. It was Japan's first Macintosh-compliant EMR (electronic medical reception chart (or record)), and continues to evolve. It now integrates use of Apple mobile devices such as the iPad, iPad Pro, iPhone, etc.

Doctor's Good Will -Three "bridges"

"Thinking", "Connection", "Relief".

"How should an electronic medical record be?"

In order to truly treat the patient, an "original appearance" and "ordinary things" records were necessary. We thought again by working back to the origin. "Once you've experienced Doctor's Good Will, we're convinced that you'll see the 'future of medical care'".
